Alice Kirkpatrick is a painter living in Pownal, Maine. She received her BA in Art from Colby College in Waterville, Maine in 1982, and has attended workshops and courses at Maine College of Art in Portland and Haystack Mountain School of Crafts on Deer Isle. After a 20-year career in the public sector, Alice decided in 2006 to pursue art full time.

Born and raised in Portland, with summers spent on the coast and Belgrade lakes, and winters in the mountains, Alice's art work is inspired by the Maine landscape and the simple houses and structures that connect people with their surroundings. Some of her recent paintings are of views at Hiram Blake Camp on Cape Rosier, where she has visited with her sister over the past 10+ years.

Currently, Alice is exploring the line between representation and abstraction in landscapes and interior spaces. Drawn to quiet places that are uninhabited yet evoking the human spirit, Alice is inspired by light, and the power it holds to transcend the literal and stir emotion. The play of light in architectural spaces and in the natural world, and subtle color transitions often make their way into her paintings.

Alice works primarily in acrylic, preferring its immediacy and the ability to work quickly and more intuitively. She is constantly taking photographs, to use for paintings or for their own sake.
